

Piher Sensors & Controls S.A. TSCA Statement

The United States Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) is a federal chemicals management regulation. Under TSCA Section 6(h) Restrictions on Persistent, Bioaccumulative and Toxic (PBT) Substances, final rules were published in January 2021 restricting five chemicals, including treated articles containing these chemicals, from distribution in U.S. commerce:

- PIP (3:1), phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1), CAS 68937-41-7.
- DecaBDE, decabromodiphenyl ether, CAS 1163-19-5.
- 2,4,6 TTBP, 2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol, CAS 732-26.
- HCBd, hexachlorobutadiene, CAS 87-68-3.
- PCTP, pentachlorothiophenol, CAS 133-49.

The parts **PT6, PS6, N6, N6-R, PT10, PTC10, PS10, PSC10, N15, PT15, PTC15, PS15, PSC15, plastic accessories (shafts & knows/thumbwheels) for these product families** and **PC16** supplied by Piher Sensors & Controls S.A. have not been found to contain the above listed Persistent, Bioaccumulative, and Toxic (PBT) substances as restricted under *US Code of Federal Regulations Title 40, part 751 – “Regulation of Certain Chemical Substances and Mixtures under Section 6 of The Toxic Substances Control Act” (TSCA) published January 6, 2021.
